



BEFORE

- Clean home thoroughly, especially the kitchen and bathrooms. Underneath the fridge and stove are commonly forgotten areas that often have food debris and trash.
- Remove items from kitchen and bathroom cabinets and from the top of the fridge and place on a table outside of the kitchen.



AFTER

- Once product is dry (usually within 30 minutes), it is safe to put items back into cabinets.
- Continue to keep home clean and free of debris. Keep food and trash cans sealed.
- Avoid cleaning up product applied on baseboards and in kitchen cabinets for two weeks.
- If activity is still seen in two weeks, schedule a follow up treatment.
- Vacuum dead roaches and eggs to prevent hatching. Dump vacuum canister/bag away from the home.

WHAT WE'LL DO:

1. A general spray in the kitchen and bathrooms and behind fridge and stove.
2. Flushing agent inserted between crevices of cabinets (Crack and Crevice service only).
3. Bait applied in/around cabinet hinges.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Roaches will eat just about anything - even each other if food is scarce!
- Females german roaches lay egg "cases" called ootheca that can contain up to 50 eggs.
- Roaches can run up to three miles an hour, which means they can spread germs and bacteria throughout a home very quickly.



Please keep in mind that your initial treatment will not eradicate the infestation. A re-treatment is almost always required in order to get behind the life cycle of this insect. It is important to schedule re-treatments every 2 weeks as recommended by the technician until pest activity has been eliminated. Thank you for your patience.
